

Classroom and Seminar Student Agreement

The training activities provided by the *Professional Home Inspectors Institute* are intended for those who wish to become Professional Home Inspectors. The keyword here is Professional.

The classroom and seminar environments are directed to students of professional caliber, yet are generally very informal.

You are about to register as a Student at the *Professional Home Inspectors Institute* and prior to registering you are agreeing to the following guidelines that must be observed by all students during attendance:

Dress and Hygiene

Neat, clean, and appropriate to the activity.

Smoking

Smoking is NOT allowed within the Facilities unless designated smoking areas are provided.

Language

Profane or abusive language is not allowed.

Punctuality

All students are to be present at the scheduled start of the seminar or class.

Alcohol and Drugs

Using, possessing, or being under the influence of these substances is not allowed and will result in immediate expulsion.

PHII seeks active and vigorous participation from its students. We do not wish to restrict open and honest discussion or dialog. We do want to maintain a professional learning and teaching environment that includes debate, discussion and comment. Within this context, we wish to restrict inappropriate behavior. Repeated inappropriate behavior may result in expulsion. Expulsion shall be at the sole discretion of the Faculty.
